

Matthew 19.14 "*...Let the children come to me, don't stop them, for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these*".

Yeshua again displays himself in humility, lowering himself so others can obtain the love of heaven. Yeshua tells his disciples not to hinder the children from coming to him because he also longs to bless them; to touch them and give them a sense of security that counts them among His beloved.

As mature believers of Yeshua Messiah we have a responsibility to assist not hinder our children to seek the Lord and allow them to hear His voice as the prophet Samuel. The Lord first spoke to the boy Samuel in 1 Samuel 3, the Lord made three separate attempts to speak with Samuel before Samuel took his focus away from man and directed his attention toward Adonai.

For our children to walk in prophetic intercession we have to give them opportunity to hear from the Lord, the One who has purposed their lives and not succumb to the voice of men.

Pray tonight as the youth of FOTBG direct their attention toward Adonai in search of His wisdom and direction for their lives. As they return to the education system rather on site or remote their contact with corruption and debauchery is certain, the presence of sin is going to be present. Without Adonai's surety and invincibility they would be tossed from one agenda to another leading them into double-mindedness decreasing the voice of the Ruach HaKodesh. Therefore, continue to encourage them as they allow Adonai to shape them into His righteous ones.
